Accommodations

Brierfield Ironworks Park has numerous campsites for RV and tent camping. Some have full hook-ups, some do not. There is a central bath house. The park also has cabins available for rent. Camping arrangements and fees must be handled through the park.

Range

The range firing line and ready area are covered and can accommodate up to 6 or 7 teams firing at one time. The ready area has 6 large tables. There are restrooms at the shooting range. A medical bag and CO2 bottle for clearing arms are maintained at the base of tower.

Food

The host team will be operating a concession stand on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday. On Friday only cold drinks, water, and coffee available. Breakfast and Lunch will be available on Saturday. Breakfast will be available on Sunday.
