****** Individual matches are classified as noted and will be awarded as follows, within the limitation of "one less than the max number of participants": Musket, carbine, revolver and their aggregates will be classified and will be awarded two places at each distance in each class. Smoothbore will be classified as "unsighted" and "sighted" and will be awarded two places at each distance and their aggregates. Breechloader will be UNCLASSIFIED and awarded two places at each distance and aggregate. Grand aggregate will be awarded three places. Five gun aggregate will be awarded two places. First, second and third place awards will also go to both junior and senior BB gun shooters.

** Team matches are unclassified and will be awarded as follows, within the limitation of "one less than the max number of teams participating": Musket, Carbine, Revolver, Smoothbore, & Repeater A teams will be awarded three places. Mortar and Cannon will be awarded three places. Musket, Carbine, Revolver, Smoothbore and Repeater B teams will be awarded one place. C teams and beyond will compete for B team medals. Junior and senior BB gun teams will be awarded a maximum of three places.

** Guest shooters will be welcome as per Rule #16.2.2.

** Campers will be charged \$5 per night for power – Hookups are limited.
