DIRECTIONS: The Smokeybottom range (aka the Turner E. Kirkland Memorial Range) is located at 870 Luther Davis Road in Hornbeak, Tennessee. Signs will direct newcomers into the range from TN Highway 21, about 5 miles west of Troy, TN (which is on U.S. Highway 51, about 5 miles south of Union City, TN).

HOST TEAM: This is a Deep South Region skirmish hosted by Co. E (the Harris Guards), 4th Tennessee Infantry Regiment, CSA/N-SSA. Turner Kirkland, late owner of Dixie Gun Works, still located in Union City, TN, was instrumental in helping establish the Harris Guards and purchasing the Smokeybottom range. Don Adams, late owner of the range, was a charter member of the Harris Guards and a fine shooter in his day.

FOOD: Food and drinks will be available at the range for breakfast and lunch on Saturday and Sunday. Restaurants are located in Union City, and at Troy and Reelfoot Lake.

MOTELS: Several motels are located in Union City, about a 15-minute drive from the range. Visit Obion County Lodging (Google it) for more information.

CAMPING: Dry camping is available at the range. There are a limited number of trailer hookups (electrical power only) -- RSVP to reserve.

UNIFORMS: Regional rules require the wearing of uniforms on Saturday and Sunday, but bring a change of cooler clothes in case of too much heat Sat afternoon. Please, no thongs.
