To all who planning to attend the 7th NC shoot in Dare County next weekend here are directions;

From up north, take 64 to 664 Monitor Merrimac Tunnel, back to 64 west, to 168 south (follow signs to Nags Head) farther down the road, 168 changes to 158 East (no turn). Follow 158 through Kitty Hawk, follow signs to Manteo and turn right onto highway 64 west, (do not turn in to Manteo). Follow 64 across the second bridge and approx 2 miles, turn left on highway 264. Approx 1¾ Miles turn right on first dirt road on right then 200 yards, turn left into gate.

From out west or down south go to 64 east follow to 264. Turn right and approx 13/4 miles turn right on first dirt road on right, then 200 yards turn left into gate.

There will be signs at the important intersections and on the range for camping area.

We are looking forward to this and will do our best to have a good shoot. We hope this new range will be a good new destination for all. Do remember this is eastern NC, we do have mosquitoes. Not bad, but they are here.

The range will be open Friday and camping will be available Thurs. afternoon. There will not be any power available at the range. If you must have hook ups the closest camp ground is in Wanchese (10 miles). Let me know and I'll send the information
