

Washtenaw Sportsmen's Club presents:
Black Powder Through the Ages 2

A one-day shooting extravaganza
Washtenaw Sportsman's Club, Ypsilanti Twp, MI
Feb. 15th, 2003

Shooters are invited to bring **any** black powder firearm, with the exclusion of those that are repeating or magazine fed (that would be unfair now wouldn't it?)

Repeaters and other firearms are welcome, however must be fired single shot, modern in-lines are also welcome.

All muzzle loading firearms must be loaded on the firing line via individual, pre-measured loading tubes (sorry, no powder horns).

5 person teams will be formed on a lottery basis. Events will be 5 minutes, N-SSA-style, using breakable targets at 50 yards. Lowest cumulative time wins.

Entry fee will be \$10 per shooter; all money (after expenses and \$5 to WSC) will be redistributed to the winning team.

Bring a friend, take his money...

Events will be as follows (subject to change without notice):

20 Clay pigeons on a cardboard backer @ 50 yds.

10 Assorted fruits and Veggies, Hanging @ 50 yds.

10 Ice blocks, hanging @ 50 yds.

10 Stale Bagels, Hanging @ 50 yds.

10 Cookies, Hanging @ 25 yds.

Schedule:

10am: range opens, paper target shooting for acclamation...

11am: Team drawing begins

Competition Begins immediately following

This range is covered and has a heated room to warm your bones by the fire. Therefore the event will be rain, snow or shine...

Following the event there will be a potluck style lunch, please bring something to pass. BYOB.

This event is open to the public.

DIRECTIONS: Traveling east on I-94, take Exit 181 to US 12 West (Michigan Avenue). Traveling west on I-94, take Exit 181A to US 12 West. Ellis Road, the first road turning left off Michigan Ave., makes two sharp turns before heading directly south about a mile to the WSC. As the pavement ends, turn left to the WSC entrance, 5095 Ellis Road. Follow road 1/4 mile to main clubhouse on the left.

Pre-registration is not required, however we would appreciate a head count prior to the event so we can be sure to provide enough targeting...
