

54th McNeill's Skirmish July 9th – 11th 2021

McNeill's Rangers and Chew's Battery cordially invite your unit to join us this July 9th – 11th at Ft Shenandoah, VA for the 54th annual skirmish begun in 1967. Team matches for Musket, Carbine, and Smoothbore will be classified. Revolver and Mortar matches will be Unclassified. Individual matches for Musket, Carbine, and Smoothbore arms will also be Classified, Individual Repeater and Revolver Matches will be Unclassified. Mortar team matches at both 100- and 200-yards Friday and Saturday afternoon (reentries possible). The Smoothbore Match will be Sunday following the Musket Match.

Reminder: N-SSA Covid19 Policy pertaining to the conduct of Virginia Skirmishes has been modified so as to be in accordance with Governor Northam's reduced restrictions that became effective May 28th, 2021.

SKIRMISH SCHEDULE

FRIDAY:

- 0930:** Registration opens, and individual matches commence.
 - All matches are ten (10) shots for score.
 - All Individual Musket, Carbine & Smoothbore matches, including aggregates, are classified. (Grand Aggregate is free).
 - All Individual Repeater and Revolver are unclassified.
 - All individual matches are awarded 3-places.
 - UNLIMITED RE-ENTRIES.
- 1530:** Last individual relay.
- 1600:** 100yd. mortar matches and 200 yd. in the hollow (positions 3-8), Air Rifle individual matches also begin at pos. 55.
- 1830:** At the conclusion of Air Rifle and mortar matches, all ranges will be closed for the day.

SATURDAY:

- 0800:** Registration opens and individual matches commence.
- 1100:** Two relays of Air Rifle individuals begin at pos. 55.
- 1215:** Revolver range closes. Set up for Revolver team match.
- 1230:** Revolver team captains' meeting on revolver range.
- 1245:** Revolver team matches commence. Three (3) N-SSA members per team.
- 1400:** Individual matches conclude. Set up for Carbine team competition.
- 1430:** Carbine team captain's meeting at the stat house followed by team matches. Five (5) N-SSA members per team.

Notes:

Thirty (30) minutes after the conclusion of the Carbine team matches, Children's Air Rifle team matches and 1 relay for Mortar matches will be held on the main range. All children competing in the team match should report to position 55. All children must be registered by 1100 Saturday to give us time to assemble target materials.

At the conclusion of the Air Rifle team matches and Mortar matches, the range will be closed.

1730: Root beer and ice cream at the Ruritans' Pavilion. Time is approximate.

SUNDAY:

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0800: Stat house opens for protests.

0900: Stat house Protest window closes.

0845: Musket company team captains' meeting at stat house followed by opening ceremonies and the Musket competition

1. 25 yd 9 - clay pigeons on a backer.
2. 25 yd 6 - hanging clay pigeons.
3. 25 yd 6 - 4" x 4" hanging tiles.
4. 25 yd 6 - hanging plaster McNeill's medallion.

CARBINE EVENTS (5 Members per team):

1. 100 yd 7 - 6" x 6" hanging tiles.
2. 50 yd 20 - clay pigeons on a backer.
3. 50 yd 5 - paper plates (2 min. rapid fire).
4. 50 yd 10 - hanging 4" X 4" tiles.
5. 50 yd 10 - hanging pigeons.

CHILDREN'S AIR RIFLE TEAM EVENTS (3 Children per team):

1. 25 ft 9 - 60 mm pigeons on a backer.
2. 25 ft 6 - 1 ½" hanging clay pots.
3. 25 ft 6 - National clay disks.

A fun team match will follow after the regular team match. Special awards will be included.

MORTAR TEAM EVENTS (4 Members per team 7 shots 5 for score):

1. 100 yd - Event on Friday afternoon at 4:00 and again Saturday at 10:30
2. 200 yd - Event on Friday afternoon at 4:00 and again Saturday at 10:30

MUSKET COMPANY EVENTS (5 Members per team):

1. 100 yd 7 - 6" x 6" hanging tiles.
2. 50 yd 20 - clay pigeons on a backer.
3. 50 yd 5 - paper plates (2 min. rapid fire).
4. 50 yd 10 - hanging 4" X 4" tiles.
5. 50 yd 10 - hanging pigeons.

SMOOTHBORE EVENTS (3 Members per team):

1. 25 yd 9 - clay pigeons on a backer.
2. 25 yd 6 - 4" tiles.
3. 25 yd 1- vertical stake.
4. 50 yd 5- 6" tiles.
