The MASON DIXON Regional Skirmish JUNE 25 – 27, 2021

The Mason Dixon Regional Skirmish will be held on June 25-27, 2021. It is hosted by Company C, 2nd United States Sharp Shooters. We will have the following team matches: Musket, Carbine, Smoothbore, Cannon, and Mortar. Uniforms must be worn for all team competitions. Revolver and Single Shot Pistol Individuals will be available, but no team matches will be held.

Individual competition will start on both ranges at 8:30 a.m. on Friday, June 25, and end at 5 p.m. on Friday. Mortars may fire from 4 p.m. until 5 p.m. on Friday.

On Saturday, June 26, the range will open at 8 a.m. for Individuals. Mortars may fire at 10 a.m. This gives mortar crews two time slots. The last relay for Individuals will end at 1:00 p.m. Carbine team captains meeting will be held at 1:15 and the Carbine Team Match will start at 1:30 p.m. The Smoothbore Match will begin one half four after the Carbine Team Match concludes. The Cannon Match will start one half hour after the Smoothbore Match ends. The range will be closed for the day after the Cannon Match.

On Sunday, June 27, team captains will meet at 8:45 and the Musket Team Match will start at 9 a.m. with opening ceremonies.

There will be a BB gun match on Saturday, one half hour after the Carbine Team Match if there are enough participants. BB gun Individuals will be Saturday morning.

We will be giving away over 200 medals for skirmishers and for BB gun. Team matches and Individuals will be classified.

Reminder: Masks and Social Distancing are required. Bring your own masks and writing instruments for filling out forms and recording scores.

* IMPORTANT *

The N-SSA Covid Policy was approved by the Board of Directors on April 14, 2021. This policy is in full effect and must be followed by ALL skirmishers and spectators. Proper mask usage and social distancing is mandatory and has to be enforced. For the safety of all attending, everyone must follow the N-SSA approved policy.

Individual matches will be 5-shot matches & classified, with the exception of aggregates. There will be 3 awards in each class and 3 awards in each aggregate for the individual matches (5-31-19 NSSA database).

There will be company competition in musket (5 persons), carbine (5 persons), smoothbore (3 persons), mortar, and cannon. There will be no Revolver or Single Shot Pistol company competition.

Team awards will be for Musket, Carbine, and Smoothbore: 5 "A" team and 3 "B" team and 2 "C" team. Mortar- 3 places for 100-yard event. Cannon- 3 places.

Team Matches (target material subject to change):

Musket - 5 person teams

50-yard targets: 20 pigeons on cardboard backer.

Two-minute rapid fire on five 6-inch paper plates on the cardboard backer. Each plate will have a special circle that will be worth 2 points if it is hit.

10 - 4 inch hanging tiles.

10 - hanging pigeons

10 – hanging wooden blocks

100 yards: Five 6 inch hanging tiles and 2 hanging ½ gallon plastic jugs

Carbine – 5 person teams

50-yard targets: 20 pigeons on cardboard backer.

Two-minute rapid fire on five 6-inch paper plates on the cardboard backer. Each plate will have a special circle that will be worth 2 points if it is hit.

10 - 4 inch hanging tiles.

10 - hanging pigeons

10 – hanging wooden blocks

100 yards: Five 6 inch hanging tiles and 2 hanging ½ gallon plastic jugs

Smoothbore – 3 person teams – all targets at 25 yards

- 9 pigeons on backer
- 6- hanging 4-inch tiles
- 6- hanging pigeons
- 6- hanging 4-inch wooden blocks

Mortar: Stake at 100 yards supplied by each team.

Cannon: Cannon silhouette and five 1 foot square sheet rock tiles.

BB Match: will be set up at the range after we see the level of interest.

The Mason Dixon is open to all teams! We would like to have this skirmish return to the days when it was one of the biggest skirmishes in the N-SSA. We want teams to sign up early to help with target preparation but all teams will be welcome even if they sign up at the Fort.
